Directions to Venue

From the North: Take the A9 south from Inverness, test ground will be signposted directly from the A9, 2.5 miles south of the Kingussie junction on the left, opposite turning into Nuide Farm. The turning is a farm junction before the dual carriageway and after the long straight.

From the South: Take the A9 north from Perth, test ground will be signposted directly from the A9, 1.5 miles after the Newtonmore/Ralia junction and after the dual carriageway section. The turning is on the right after the dual carriageway and before the long straight. For safety pull into the left side at Nuide Farm and allow traffic to pass before crossing over the A9.
